What the Funding Supported

Fiscal Year 2023

- August Ahrens Elementary — phase two of the whole-school renovation.
- 'Ewa Elementary — repairs and maintenance.
- Honowai Elementary — electrical upgrades and air conditioning for portable classrooms.
- Lehua Elementary — campus improvements with state and federal financing.
- Palisades Elementary — outdoor covered playcourt.

Fiscal Year 2025

- August Ahrens Elementary — whole-school renovation work, covered walkway, and shelter.
- Honowai Elementary — accessibility improvements.
- Holomua Elementary — planning and design for a new three-story classroom building; amount unresolved.
- Mānana Elementary — library and administration window replacement.
- Pearl City High — tennis-court resurfacing and medical-classroom renovation.
- Waipahu High — security fencing and gates and tennis-court resurfacing.
- Waipahu Intermediate — air-conditioning repairs.
- James Campbell High — athletic-complex improvements.

Important Notes

- ¹ Holomua Elementary: The FY25 act names plans and design for a new three-story classroom building, but the amount could not be assigned confidently from the two-column PDF extraction. It is excluded from the FY25 total.
- ² Lehua Elementary: The FY23 project appears to combine approximately \$1.5 million in state general-obligation bond authority and \$6 million in federal authority for campus improvements.
- ³ FY26 priority pool: An \$18 million EDN100 CIP pool names Waipahu High's softball field and Waipahu Intermediate's covered athletic court as priorities. Because the act does not divide the pool by campus, neither school is assigned a dollar amount.
- The FY25 verified total excludes the unresolved Holomua amount.

Area Project for a Future School

East Kapolei High School in Ho'opili. The FY24 budget included \$15 million for design and construction of this planned campus. It is not credited to Kapolei High or James Campbell High because it concerns a separate future school.

Fiscal Year 2024

- Mānana Elementary — portable-classroom restroom facilities.
- Pearl City Elementary — campus waterline replacement.
- Pearl City High — auditorium lighting and electrical improvements.
- Pearl City Highlands Elementary — electrical upgrades.
- Waipahu Elementary — cafeteria expansion and renovation; planning and design for facilities, infrastructure, and parking.
- Waipahu High — campus-wide exterior repainting.
- Highlands Intermediate — covered bus stop and seating area.
- 'Ilima Intermediate — planning and design for a performing-arts building and parking.
- Waipahu Intermediate — DREAMS building for digital media, robotics, engineering, electronics, animation, music, and science.
- James Campbell High — athletic stadium and support facilities.

Fiscal Year 2026

- James Campbell High — \$9 million for continued phased Title IX work on the athletic stadium and support facilities.
- Waipahu High and Waipahu Intermediate — named priorities in an \$18 million pooled appropriation; individual amounts were not specified.
